

Intensive Islāmic Studies Programme

Dar al Quran is currently accepting enrolments for our full-time programme. Students can choose from two programme streams outlined below.

Our unique programme aims to give young men a strong grounding in Islam. The programme has a rigorous academic focus while also giving equal attention to personal development.

The programme is designed for young men transitioning from high school to university, or who are homeschooling. If you don't fit this criteria, you are still encouraged to send an expression of interest and we can assess your suitability for the programme during this process.

Sheikh Qays is hafiz of Quran and has studied the Islamic sciences in Fiji, New Zealand, and South Africa. He has completed a certificate in Islamic Chaplaincy, and in addition to his Islamic studies, he has completed his Bachelors of Arts. Beyond his formal studies, he has a passion for working with Muslim youth, and experience in serving and developing community programmes.

Fees

Students are encouraged to become supporters to help sustain Dar al Quran. Fees are waived for regular supporters. All donations are eligible for a 33% tax refund as we are a registered charitable organisation. For students who prefer not to become regular supporters there is a cost of \$1,500.00 per term.

Dress Code

All students are expected to wear a uniform that reflects the sunna of the Prophet ﷺ.

Boys Uniform:

1. Plain coloured thobe
2. Hat / topi (sunna cap)
3. No visible branding under or over the thobe

*Students may wear clothes appropriate for outdoor play under their uniforms. For boys, shorts must cover the knees (awra).
